We empower women to move beyond violence. We do this by providing safe shelter and support services to women and children experiencing domestic violence.

We operate two shelters for at-risk women who have no safe place to stay: Haven House in Cambridge and Anselma House in Kitchener. We also run a free, confidential, outreach program, which is accessed by contacting our 24/7 support lines.

While we are seeing the pandemic climate shift from previous years, it continues to be an especially difficult time for women facing domestic violence. During COVID-19, domestic violence increased and escalated, and rates of femicide hit an all-time high. It's crucial that we continue having conversations about domestic violence to raise awareness and funds.

Every 6 days in Canada, a woman is killed by her intimate partner. In 2021, there was a 26 per cent increase in femicides compared to the previous year, and in the first six months of 2022 alone, 88 femicides have been reported. We must continue raising awareness and funds to prevent these tragedies from happening.

That's why this November, we invite you to join in Voices Empower: Walk to Break the Silence. Join us in walking from Uptown Square to Town Square on November 19, 2022. This 6km walk is a time to reflect on the woman who is killed every six days by an intimate partner. Quick Facts:

- Every 6 days in Canada, a woman is killed by her intimate partner.
- There are approximately 82 domestic homicides in Canada each year.
- In the first six months of 2022 alone,
 88 femicides have been reported.
- The group most at risk for domestic homicide are aged 15-24.
