# Summary of Role:

Safe Steps is a psychoeducational group that supports caregivers to discover ways to support their children in dealing with emotions, repairing attachment, and building self-esteem and resilience. There is one caregivers' group and three age-based children's groups. Safe Steps is open to families that are not currently in crisis and is always focused on the impact of domestic violence on children.

### Support to this Position:

The Clinical Support Worker will provide primary support for these volunteers. Secondary support will be provided by the Outreach Manager.

#### Tasks and Duties

- Support with set-up and clean-up before and after group
- Assist participants to enter and exit the building before and after group
- Have a presence alongside facilitators for the duration of the group, and assist where extra support is most needed (ie. Children's group)
